With reference to the above subject, a rapid species assessment was conducted by the Ramanathapuram Wildlife Forest Range team, along with biologists, on 02/01/2025 in both Sakkarakottai and Therthangal Bird Sanctuaries in response to the query raised by the Ramsar Secretariat on 13/12/2024. Based on the assessment, the following results were obtained:

- 1. Sakkarakottai Bird Sanctuary: There are no changes in the species list which was previously submitted 124 birds, 69 butterflies, 10 mammals, 14 reptiles, 8 amphibians, and 165 plant species.
- 2. Therthangal Bird Sanctuary: There is a reduction in the species list. The current species list is as follows:
 - o Birds: 96
 - o Butterflies: 57
 - o Mammals: 7
 - o Reptiles: 11
 - o Amphibians: 6
 - Plant Species: 133 (The data sheet for the rapid assessment is attached for your reference).

It is pertinent to mention that the above-mentioned species data is different from that of the management plans because the management plan was prepared using past data. However, the above-mentioned species list is based on the most recent surveys conducted after the preparation of the management plans.
