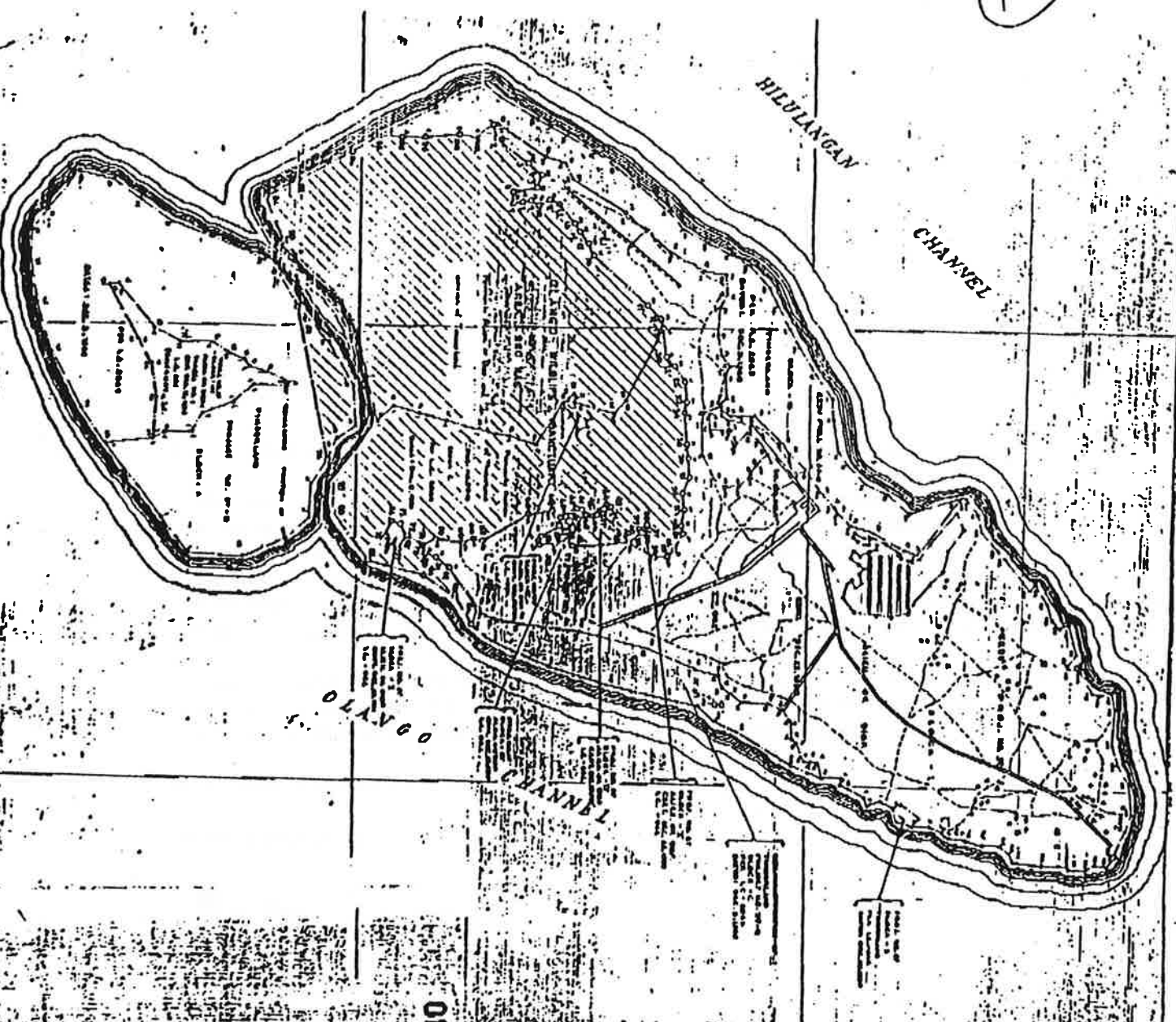

OLANGO WILDLIFE SANCTUARY was designated on July 1, 1975, under the provisions of the Wildlife Act of 1972 (Act No. 9483). The sanctuary covers an area of 1,520 hectares and is situated in the northern part of Cebu. It is bounded by the sea to the north and east, and by the municipalities of Larayan and Mandaue to the south and west. The sanctuary is a natural habitat for various species of birds, mammals, and reptiles. It is also a source of timber and other forest products. The sanctuary is managed by the Division of Forestry and Wildlife Sanctuaries, Department of Commerce and Natural Resources, Cebu City, Philippines.
