

## Additional information to **4CA021**

The wetland type for intertidal mud, sand or saltflats is **G**, not 7. Additionally wetland type **E**, sand, shingle or pebble shores applies. Justification can be found under the “physical features” section.

Criteria: 1a, 1c, 2b, 2c, 3a, 3b,3c

Justification of part of the criteria:

2b/2c: The site supports the largest assemblage of shorebird species during fall migration in all of North America.

3b: The site is very important for waders, and besides that it is used by several species of geese, ducks and seaducks.

3c: The site regularly hosts over 1% of the population of *Calidris pusilla*. (information derived from Waterfowl Population Estimates II)

The site falls under IUCN category IV.
