Additional information to **4CA023**

The wetland type description refers to 4 wetland types: permanent saline lakes \mathbf{Q} , seasonal saline lakes \mathbf{R} , permanent saline marshes \mathbf{Sp} and seasonal saline marshes \mathbf{Ss} .

The altitude of Quill Lakes is 510 m above sea level (taken from the first RIS for this site).

Criteria: 1a, 2a, 2b 2c, 3a, 3b, 3c

Justification of some of the criteria:

2a: the site supports the globally threatened species *Charadrius melodus* and *Grus americanus*. 2b/2c: The site is a very important staging area for waders during spring and autumn. Besides that, it is an important breeding site for North American population of waterfowl.
