# A WETLAND OF ARMENIA TO BE INCLUDED IN THE LIST OF WETLANDS OF INTERNATIONAL IMPORTANCE

Name: Arpi

Area: 7.3 km in length and 4.3 km in width

Location: North-West of Armenia, in the ravine of Ashotzk

mountain, from 41°00' 35" - 41°05' 40" of the northern

width, from 43°35' 40" - 43°39' 35" of the eastern

length (indicated on the map attached to this ANNEX)

#### Description

#### 1. Topography

Arpi, a lake, has the altitude of 2 x 023 meters above the sea level with the average depth of 4.2 meters, maximum depth of 8 meters. The lake is natural. Waters of several small rivers, springs and melted snow waters fall into it. Only one river, Akhurian starts from the lake. In winter it freezes.

#### Vegetation

For the present, water plants of the lake (in view of artificial raising of the lake's water level by 10m.) have become intensely poor and, chiefly, thickets of reed (Phraymites australis) are to be presented. Earlier Nuphar luteum, Nuphae candida, Cullitriche hermaphroditica had been growing here abundantly being rare species nowadays. Around the lake there is a marsh-ridden area that is turned to meadow and meadow-steppe zones. Nearer to the lake on the mentioned area Carex leporina is dominated. Scilla rosem, Trollius ranunculinus, etc. found as rare species in Armenia are plentiful here. Besides, in environs of the lake grow such rare species in Armenia as Iris sibirica, Gladiolus imbricatus, Traunsteinera sphaerica, Allium aucheri, etc.

Thus, meadows and meadow-steppe areas are in good state in environs of the lake, that are not preserved in any other preserve of Armenia.

#### 3. Birds

The following taxonomic groups of birds occur rather

frequently in the reservoir of Arpi: Podicipitiformes - species Podiceps ruficollis; Pelecaniformes - Pelecanus crispus; Ciconiiformes - Ciconia ciconia, C.nigera; Anseiformes - Casarca ferruginea, Tadorna tadorna, Anas platyrhynchos, A. vecca, A acuta, A. querquedula, A. clypeata, Aythya fuligula, A.ferina; Gruiformes - Grus grus; Charadiiformes - Charadius alexandrinus, Tringa ochropus, T. totanus, Actitis hypoleucos, Philomachus pugnax, Calidris minus, Gallinago media, G. gallinago, Larus canus, L. ridibundus, L. argentatus, Sterna albifrons, S. hirundo and many other bird species. from the mentioned birds Pelecanus crispus, Ciconia nigra, Grus grus, Larus argentatus are included in the Red Book.

## Other animal species

Over 15 species of mammals are met with here. The fauna of reptiles is poor. There are 8 species of fish here including Salmo fario.

## 4. Legal protection

Materials are prepared to include this wetland as a protection area in the system of preserves of the Republic of Armenia.
