<u>Criterion 1:</u> The habitat of stony islets with northern Atlantic seabird colonies is very rare in Denmark.

<u>Criterion 2:</u> The site is a nationally important breeding site for the red listed bird Rock Pipit (*Anthus spinoletta*)

<u>Criterion 6:</u> The site supports more than 1% of the individuals in the population of the Common Eider (*Somateria mollissima*)16,200 – 1,1% of the Baltic/Denmark/Netherlands population.

Sea area approx. 8 km north of Læsø (Ramsar area No. 160). Nearest town is Vesterø. Administrative region is Nordjylland County.

One of the most important breeding sites in Denmark for Black Guillemot (*Cepphus grylle*), which has been a red listed species in Denmark until 1997. The area is also a nationally important breeding site for the red listed Rock Pipit (*Anthus spinoletta*) and breeding area and haul-out for Common Seal.

breeding birds. Potential threats are illegal landings and disturbance of breeding waterbirds and seals.

Admittance is forbidden by Læsø municipality in the breeding season, except for local fishermen. The whole area is identical with the EU Bird Protection Area No. 9 and included in EU Habitat Protection area No. 176.
