

<u>Criterion 2:</u> The site is an important breeding area for waterbirds, some of which are on the Danish red list, e.g. *Botaurus stellaris, Philomachus pugnax,* and *Sterna albifrons*.

<u>Criterion 4:</u> The site is one of the most important moulting areas in Denmark for Mute Swan (*Cygnus olor*).

<u>Criterion 6</u>: The site regularly supports more than 1% of the individuals in the populations for the following species (count data 1999):

The site is one of the most important moulting areas in Denmark for Mute Swan (*Cygnus olor*). The site is a resting and feeding area for waterbirds (count data 1999):

Dark bellied Brent Goose (*Brante b. bernicla*) 105 Wigeon (*Anas poenelope*) 2,622 Tufted Duck (*Aythya fuligula*) 2,007 Eider (*Somateria mollissima*) 2,951 Goldeneye (*Bucephala clangula*) 2,072 Red Breasted Merganser (*Mergus serrator*) 502 Coot (*Fulica atra*) 5,769 Breeding area for aquatic and salt marsh birds including *Phalacrocorax carbo*, *Botaurus stellaris*, *Circus aeruginosus*, *Recurvirostra avosetta*, *Philomachus pugnax*, *Sterna sandvicensis*, *Sterna paradisaea*, *Sterna hirundo*, *Sterna albifrons*.

Territorial waters, private, the State represented by the Ministry of Environment.

22. Factors (past, present or potential) adversely affecting the site's ecological character, including changes in land use and development projects: (a) at the site (b) around the site

There is a decline in cattle grazing causing overgrowth of small islands; drainage and cultivation schemes have degraded the breeding habitats for waterbirds since the turn of the century.

Negative effect on submerged vegetation due to eutrophication. Increasing eutrophication has resulted in very low oxygen levels in the bottom substrate.

Human disturbance on uninhabited islands is a potential threat

23. Conservation measures taken: (national category and legal status of protected areas - including any boundary changes which have been made: management practices; whether an officially approved management plan exists and whether it has been implemented)

Nature conservation: Vejlen (50 hectares) and Monnet (122 hectares) on Tåsinge. Monnet and some of the small islands are protected against public access in the birds' breeding season.

By a Ministerial Order, hunting from motor boats has been prohibited north of Ærøskøbing (Ærø island) in order to reduce hunting pressure on and disturbance of waterbirds.

The whole area is identical with the EU Bird Protection Area No. 71. The site overlaps partly the EU Habitat Protection Site No. 111.

Part of the Ramsar site is a Wildlife reserve.
