Location On the coast between the city of Libreville and Port Gentil, about 50km south of Libreville, western Gabon.

National Designations Presidential Reserve; Domaine de chasse^P (Hunting area - Wong -Wongé 25,000ha; Grand Bam-Bam 20,000ha; Petit Bam-Bam 35,000ha).

Principal Features An extensive coastal region composed of plains, gently rolling hills and plateaux. The site is bounded to the west by the Atlantic; to the north by the Aouagne and Pambo-Nyango rivers; to the east by Lake Azingo; and to the south by the rivers Gongoue, Oranga, Wanga, Bembelie & Mpogoue, and Lakes Inyongo & Nguelie. The area is dissected by a number of small coastal rivers, while vegetation varies from humid tropical forest to stunted woodland savanna with thickets of stunted *Aucoumea klaineana*. Notable mammals include *Loxodonta africana*, *Pan troglodytes* and *Gorilla gorilla gorilla*. Birds include *Pelecanus onocrotalus*. (1a,2a,3b)

Conservation Issues Access is strictly limited to those granted personal permission by the President of Gabon. No recent information concerning the site's ecological character has been received.
