

3. Setté Cama

Geographical Coordinates 02°40'S 10°05'E **Area** 220,000ha

Location On the coast, about 325km south of the city of Libreville and 125km north-west of the town of Mayumba, south-west Gabon. Just to the south of site number 2 (Petit Loango).

Date of Ramsar Designation 30 December 1986.

Other International Designations None.

National Designations Wildlife Reserve^P (Réserve de faune - plaine d'Ouanga 20,000ha); Hunting Area^P (Domaine de chasse - Setté Cama 200,000ha).

Principal Features A slightly undulating coastal plain penetrated by an extensive lagoon and dissected by several small rivers. The site's vegetation is composed of open savanna, with thickets along the coast, and rain forest. Some parts of the forest are subject to regular flooding. Mammals include *Loxodonta africana*, *Trichechus senegalensis*, *Pan troglodytes*, *Gorilla gorilla gorilla* and *Panthera pardus*. (2a)

Conservation Issues No recent information concerning the ecological character of the site has been received.
