Three islands and a number of small islets. The islands have rich, grassy vegetation and several freshwater ponds, whereas the islets are barren and rocky. Dunoyane is one of the most important breeding and moulting areas for Barnacle Goose and Common Eider on Spitsbergen.

The flat, grassy islands are surrounded by a shallow and nutrient rich sea area.
